

Woven Cables *...a pattern by Knitty Gritty Thoughts*

DIFFICULTY LEVEL - Beginner/Intermediate

This is a great project for a beginner wanting to learn cables or a fast knit for an intermediate knitter. With only two patterned rows in a 12 row repeat it goes quicker than you think (and looks a lot more complicated!)

MATERIALS

Cashmere Luxury Aran (7 skeins) or substitute approximately 700 yds of another worsted weight yarn. Some good choices? Debbie Bliss Cashmerino Aran, Cascade 220, KnitPicks Wool of the Andes or any other worsted weight yarn will do.

US 7 and US 5 needles or appropriate size for gauge.

Cable needle

A row counter is very helpful for this project

GAUGE - 5sts/inch in cable pattern.

FINISHED SIZE - (56in x 7in wide pre-blocking)

ABBREVIATIONS

k - knit

p - purl

RS - right side

WS - wrong side

CO - cast on

BO - bind off

st(s) - stitch(es)

cn - cable needle



Cable 10 front – Slip 5sts to cn and hold to front, knit 5sts and then knit 5sts from cn.

Cable 10 back – Slip 5sts to cn and hold to back, knit 5sts and then knit 5sts from cn.

PATTERN REPEAT

Pattern Repeat is worked over 12 rows-

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 (WS): Purl.

Row 3: K1, Cable 10 front, *K5, cable 10 front; rep from * to last 6 stitches, K6.

Rows 4-8: Work in St st, starting with purl row.

Row 9: K6, Cable 10 back, *K5, cable 10 back; rep from * to last st, K1.

Rows 10-12: Work in St st, starting with purl row.

Repeat rows 1-12.

PATTERN

CO 62 sts. Start 12 row pattern repeat, and work until scarf measures the desired length, ending with row 4 (WS Row). Using a needle 2 sizes smaller than your pattern needle, bind off all sts on RS. Weave in ends and block.

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
